Maintenance and improvement of facilities

- Only essential maintenance has happened during this last 12 months, mainly because of need to rebuild cash stocks due to lack of income post covid.
- Grass cutting continued (thanks to Michael Johnson) and outside area kept tidy (thanks to Tessa, John, Fritz and many others)
- Maintenance tasks include renovating and painting exterior woodwork and gutters, repointing the patio.
- We have now installed computerised booking system and remote control of our heating system
- We are currently in the process of upgrading: the tables in the centre, a new honour boards for the skittles teams and thank you to Frank Teasdale for volunteering to create a new updated outdoor sign to replace the deteriorated one in situ
- Looking ahead, the plumbing is now starting to need more urgent attention to allow better heating controls in the winter along with looking at energy efficiency measures such as lighting.
- (Side note thanks to Frank as we now believe that issue with the lack of water in the taps that occurs with high traffic at the beer festival has hopefully been identified and rectified!)

Finance

- Huge thanks to David Purdy for handling the finances over the last 12 months.
- Bar trade has continued to recover this year gross profit has increased thanks to Tom Redman's skilled negotiations with suppliers. Both the club and the trust have now recovered the minimum cash threshold Max Boulton recommended (many years ago) that we keep at all times as a safety buffer in case of emergency - however we are looking to increase and maintain this threshold by 15% for inflationary reasons.
