

Seend Parish Community Facilities Report | Regulation 14 Draft 2019

Seend Parish is home to a range of community activity which is centred around a variety of community facilities and services. Map 1 and Table 1 below identify these community facilities and services to be protected in the Seend Parish Neighbourhood Plan. Wiltshire Council defines rural facilities and services as those that benefit the local community such as local shops, meeting places, sports venues, cultural buildings, public houses and places of worship (Wiltshire Core Strategy, paragraph 6.71). There is a need to protect and encourage the development of rural services and facilities in Seend Parish to ensure that it can continue to meet a number of the day to day needs of the community.

Map 1 (opposite) Seend Parish Community Facilities and Services

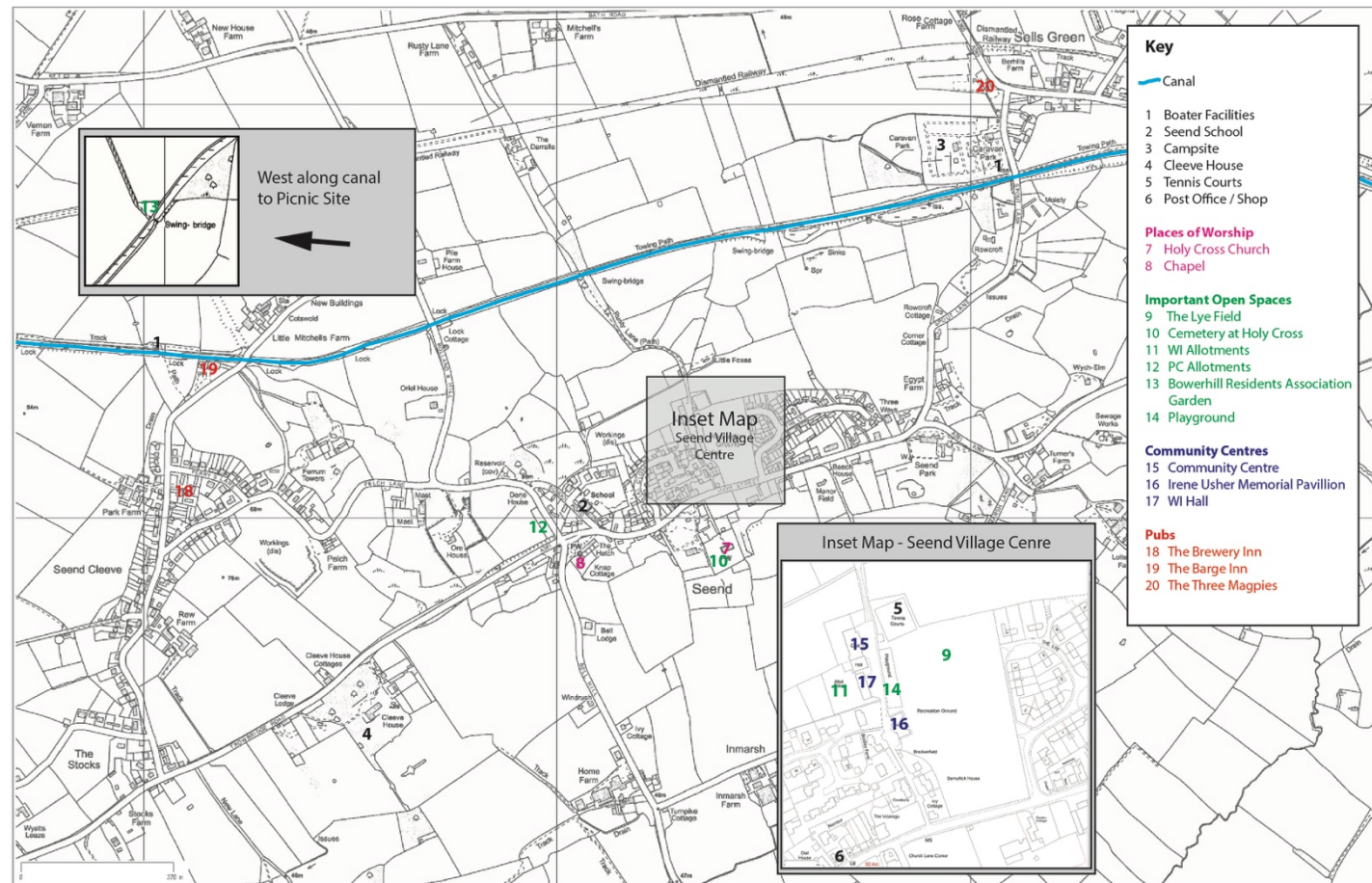

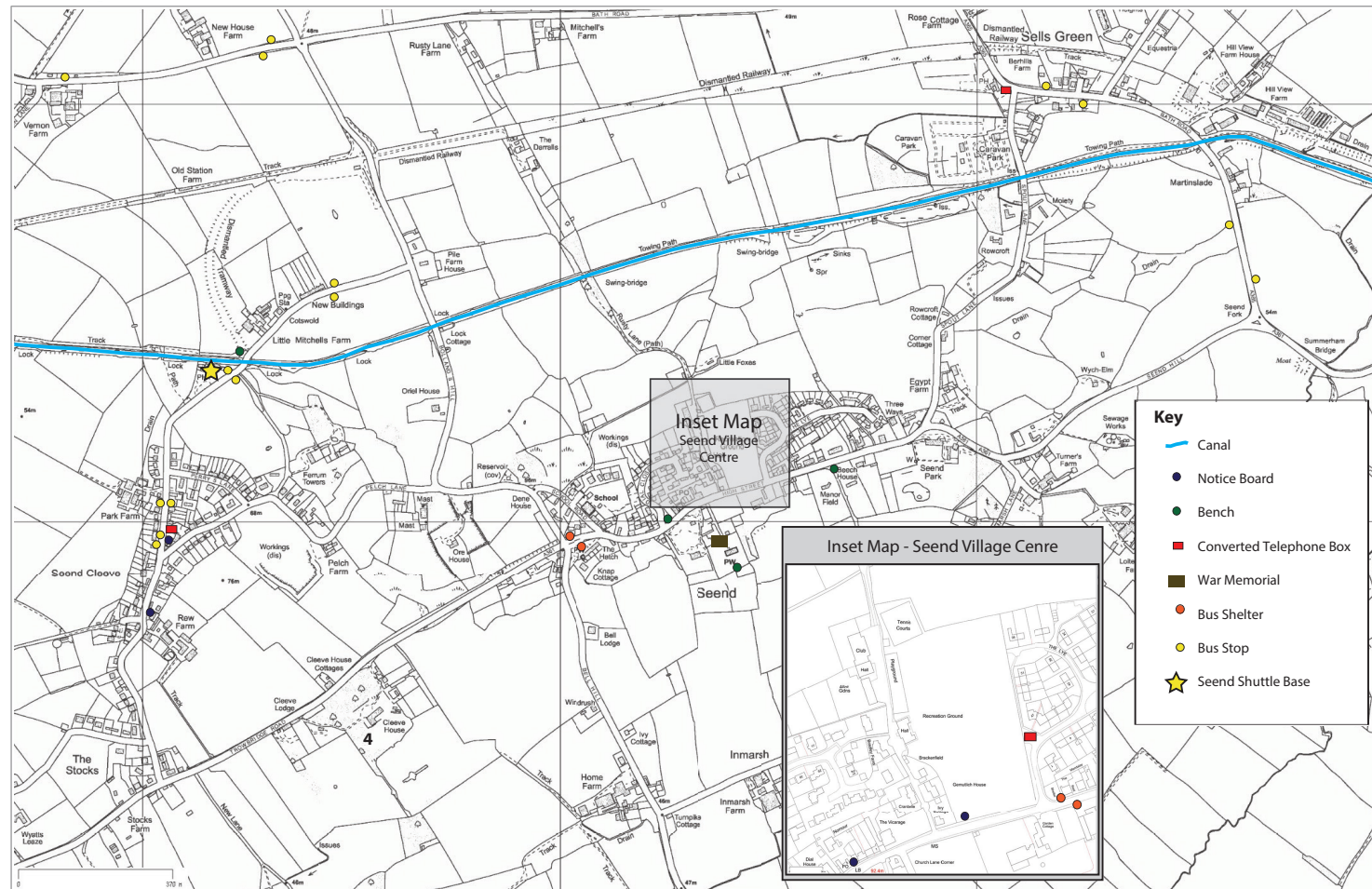
