

Green Infrastructure & Routeways

- Green Infrastructure (GI) is a term used to cover the network of all the different green spaces and routes in an area and the way that they do, or do not, connect together.
- Seend Parish has an extensive network of routeways and pedestrian, cycle and bridleway connections, including part of the Mid-Wiltshire Way and the Kennet and Avon Canal.
- The Parish also has good provision of other GI features such as Sites of Special Scientific Interest, allotments and locally identified important tree canopies.
- Part of the GI work involves identifying aspirations for enhancement of the green infrastructure network. This could include things like promoting 'quiet lanes', providing more public recreation space in identified places, and creating better connections between the canal and the settlements.
- The canal is a key element in the Seend Parish GI network.
