

SEEND SHORT MAT BOWLS CLUB

Seend Short Mat Bowls Club was founded in 1999, bowls being one of the activities requested in response to the Village Appraisal Questionnaire organized by Tony Ewin in that year.

At that time all the 31 people who signed up for the club lived in or very close to Seend itself. In the years between 1999 and the present day the number of local members has reduced to just 2 people – the present membership total of 33 being made up of 8 whose main clubs are in Trowbridge, Melksham and Market Lavington, and a large but welcome contingent of Bromham players who became refugees when their Social Centre burnt down in 2021.

At present many of our bowlers participate in a variety of Leagues and Tournaments organized by the County Association, but looking into the future I can foresee a situation when the Bromham venue is rebuilt and Seend Club will be advertising for new members.
